HSUHK holds seminar on Dr Sun Yat-sen's inspiration for global development

The Hang Seng University of Hong Kong (HSUHK) and Yazhou Zhoukan held a symposium titled "Dr Sun Yat-sen's Inspiration for Global Development" on 12 March. The symposium commemorated the 100th anniversary of Dr Sun Yat-sen's passing and brought together nearly 100 participants, including prominent experts and figures, such as historians, researchers in the field of politics, leaders in culture and education, and international relations experts, as well as students and members of the public, to reflect on Dr Sun's contributions and influence. The symposium also fostered discussions among experts from different fields on Dr Sun Yat-sen's intellectual legacy and its implications for contemporary global development.

The symposium also featured a discussion session during which attendees engaged in deep exchanges about the modern applications of Dr Sun's ideas.
